Please make sure your child's water bottle only has water in it for school & nursery. It is upsetting for children who bring water and then see their friends having juice, the rule is water except for at lunchtimes when they can have a juice bottle or similar in their lunchbox. Most children will drink water in school, even if they choose not to at home.

COVID-19 update: From Thursday 24th February the legal requirement to self-isolate following a positive test has been removed. However, if someone tests positive the advice is to stay at home, and avoid contact with others for at least five full days. Many people will no longer be infectious to others after 5 days. You may choose to take an LFD test from 5 days after your symptoms started (or the day your test was taken if you did not have symptoms) followed by another LFD test the next day.
