MOBILE PHONES: We do not encourage children to bring mobile phones into school, however we respect that you may want your child to carry a mobile phone if they are walking to/from school. If your child brings a mobile phone or any other personal electronic device to school they must bring it up to the office when they arrive in school. The phone will be held securely until the end of the day when they may collect it just before they leave school. Personal mobile devices must not be used on the school site; if your child needs to contact you before they leave the site they will be able to use the school landline.

WATER BOTTLES: Please make sure your child comes to school every day with a bottle of fresh water. Please make sure your child gets into the habit of bringing their water bottle home after school so it can be refilled. Water bottles should be clearly named so your child can easily identify their bottle. **YOUR CHILD SHOULD ONLY HAVE WATER IN THEIR WATER BOTTLE. BOTTLES ARE ABLE TO BE REFILLED DURING THE SCHOOL DAY.**



UNIFORM: Uniform for both schools can now be ordered through the website under the tab “Tibshelf Schools” or you [can click here to place an order](#)

A lot of high street stores stock burgundy uniform, if that is a preferable option for you. Pre-owned uniform can be purchased or exchanged in the cabin at Tibshelf Infants & Nursery School; there is a large amount of stock there (including larger sizes) in the boxes and hanging on the rail. This can be brought to Town End on request.

We keep a good stock of uniform at Tibshelf Infants, so usually what you have ordered will be at Town End within a couple of days. When you have paid your child’s uniform will be given to them, but please remind us if this has not happened.

PLEASE MAKE SURE ALL UNIFORM IS CLEARLY NAMED AS THERE ARE ABOUT 200 CHILDREN IN SCHOOL CURRENTLY. Please also encourage your child to look after and respect their uniform; we will also do this in school as we know how many items of clothing are mislaid over a school week and end up in the lost property box. You are always welcome to check this; it is located just inside the doors off the small playground outside the wheelchair accessible toilet.

Please make sure your child comes to school every day with a waterproof and weatherproof coat. **NO SCARVES PLEASE.**

Please ensure your child brings a change of shoes or wellington boots to school in a bag on their outdoor learning day, especially as the weather is likely to change over the next few weeks.

HEADLICE: Please make sure you check your child’s head on at least a weekly basis. It is really important that you treat your child’s head immediately if you find any sign of headlice. You will be able to get further information Facebook @OnceAWeekTakeAPeek
