Dear Parents/Carers,



Thank you for all your very generous donations for the poppy appeal, we raised £213.91 at this school, and £189.16 at Town End – a great amount across both schools! Also thank you for your support for Children in Need, we raised £145.20 at this school and £116.50 at Town End – an amazing amount across both schools that has been banked this week! We know how difficult things are for many of you, so we do appreciate your support for these national causes that do so much good.



ELF DAY: Next Friday, 2nd December your child may come to school in Christmas jumpers, elf costumes, or Christmas clothes – sensible shoes please. It is our Christmas Market so the gates will open at 8am and you are welcome to have a wander round, see Santa and his Christmas pony, buy your reindeer food & hot chocolate, and enjoy a festive start to the school day before dropping your child as usual. The gates will also be open at 2pm for you to enjoy these festivities at the end of the school day.

APPLYING FOR A SCHOOL PLACE: Please make sure that you apply for a Year 3 place if your child is currently in Year 2, or a Reception place if your child is born between 1st September 2018 and 31st August 2019. You **MUST** apply by midnight on 15th January to get them a place. [Apply online at by clicking here.](#)

THE FRIENDS CHRISTMAS SHOP: Your child will have the opportunity to visit The Christmas Shop over the next couple of weeks if you returned their envelope detailing the presents they needed to buy. These can still be sent into school if you missed the deadline.



PANTOMIME: This year our pantomime day is on Thursday 15th December. All children in school have a seat booked, the cost per child is £13. If your child is in receipt of Pupil Premium funding school will pay, but you must complete the consent form, if you have problems with this please let us know. There are some seats available for nursery children (who must be accompanied by an adult) and for adults of children in school. These extra seats will be allocated on a first come basis. We will let you know when they are on School Gateway to book. Your child will need to bring a snack box and a drink. Children in school will have lunch on their return to school but this is not until after 12.30pm. In the past The Friends have provided a snack bag, but with so many differing tastes and dietary requirements, it has been easier over past years to ask children to provide their own.

ONLINE SAFETY: Keeping your children safe online in school, and educating them about how to stay safe online at home is a key focus for us. All staff have had the required annual training this month. You can support us by being aware of and engaging with games they are playing and their online activity so that they can talk to you about what they are accessing and sharing online. YEAR 1 CHILDREN WILL CONTINUE TO GO TO THE ALLOTMENT ON THURSDAY AFTERNOONS.

YEAR 2 WILL RESUME THEIR VISITS TO THE ALLOTMENT IN SPRING TERM 2.

Please make sure your child comes to school in suitable P.E. kit on those days. Hair should be tied up and **if your child usually wears ear-rings these should be removed or covered prior to coming to school.**

NURSERY/DUCKLINGS – WELLY BOOT WEDNESDAY: On Wednesdays your child should come to nursery wearing their puddlesuit and wellington boots. They will be outside all session so please make sure that as the weather gets colder they are well wrapped up and have gloves and hats.



UNIFORM: Uniform for both schools can now be ordered through the website under the tab “Tibshelf Schools” or you [can click here to place an order](#). Pre-owned uniform can be purchased or exchanged in the cabin, there is a large amount of stock there in the boxes and hanging on the rail.

WATER BOTTLES: Please make sure your child comes to school every day with a bottle of fresh water. Please make sure your child gets into the habit of bringing their water bottle home after school so it can be refilled. On the occasions that you may forget to send your child to school with a water bottle you will be able to purchase a bottle from the office at a cost of 50p. If your child needs a bottle of water during the school day Chris will send you a text to let you know one has been given and money is owing. Water bottles should be clearly named so your child can easily identify their bottle. Your child’s water bottle should be put in the trolley under where the reading books are stored. You will see it is clearly labelled. **YOUR CHILD SHOULD ONLY HAVE WATER IN THEIR WATER BOTTLE. BOTTLES ARE ABLE TO BE REFILLED DURING THE SCHOOL DAY WITH WATER FROM THE CLASSROOMS, THIS IS SUITABLE FOR DRINKING.**

SNACK: During the morning your child will be offered a piece of fruit as provided through the Free Fruit School Scheme. There is a variety provided during the week which consists of apples, pears, oranges, carrots, bananas etc. as in season. Your child will also be encouraged to drink their water throughout the day.

CLOTHING: Please make sure any uniform your child wears to school is clearly named. This is especially important for sweatshirts, cardigans and coats. It may be a good idea to attach a keyring with a small figure to the zip pull to help your child to recognise their coat more easily! If your child comes out of school at the end of the day without their cardigan or sweatshirt, please send them back in to collect it – having items named makes this so much easier! Clothes that are left at the end of the day will be hung on your child’s peg (if named) or put onto the trolley that is put outside nursery every morning. **Please make sure your child comes to school every day with a waterproof and weatherproof coat. NO SCARVES PLEASE.**

WARM BANK → **TIBSHELF VILLAGE HALL**

Starting from 1st November, Tibshelf Village Hall will open its doors to the public on Tuesday afternoons, 12:30pm to 3pm, each week of the winter. This is initially to test demand, and could be extended to more days and times if needed. The Hall will offer a warm space so that people can turn off their heating for a few hours. Join us for bingo, pub quiz, board games and a children's toy corner. We ask that residents in genuine need attend, although we will not turn people away.

COMMUNITY CAFE → **TIBSHELF VILLAGE HALL**

A Community Café will be open at the Village Hall during the Warm Bank and operating out of kitchen hatch. It is planned this will provide teas and coffees, as well as food being on offer. It too will initially test demand and would be extended if the Warm Bank is. We also ask that residents in genuine need attend, although none will be turned away.

JEWELLERY: CHILDREN ARE NOT ALLOWED TO WEAR ANY JEWELLERY TO SCHOOL. THIS INCLUDES TOY JEWELLERY, BRACELETS, WATCHES (unless your child can tell the time) & EARRINGS (other than plain studs). Please support us with this. Thank you.
