At Tibshelf Infant and Nursery School we weave cultural capital through our curriculum to enable children to become successful adults. Special events such as Whole School Learning Days, celebrations and support for community, local, national and international events (Tibshelf Green Bunch projects, Friends events, Sports Day & Summer Fayre, Children in Need) provide opportunities for parents and carers to come into school and experience special moments with their child. Children across school have a wide range of opportunities to connect with nature, their school community, local community and the wider community.

As a school we recognise the importance of Personal, Social and Health Education including Relationship, Sex Education and Religious Education in preparing our children to live and thrive in culturally and ethnically diverse modern Britain. School priories such as reading and vocabulary development encourage children and parents and carers to use language in aspirational ways to broaden their understanding and use of words and phrases.
