Dear Parents/Carers,

For those of you who may not have met me, my name is Mr Worrall. I am pleased to inform you that I have been appointed the new Head of School at Town End Junior School. You will be able to find me most mornings at the school gates so please do come and say hello! Equally if there is anything that you need to discuss in more detail, then I am more than happy to arrange a meeting at a time that works for you.

As part of this new role, I have also been appointed as the Designated Safeguarding Lead at Town End Junior School, taking over from Mrs Andrews who has left the school. I will be working closely in my new role alongside Mrs Boswell and Mrs Crabtree. We believe that one of the best ways to safeguard children is to equip them with the knowledge and skills for how they can keep themselves safe. Safeguarding themes are threaded through our curriculum; some examples include, our Jigsaw scheme delivered across school, safeguarding assemblies and through whole school themed days such as 'Safer Internet Day.'
