Dear Parents/Carers,

Re: Whole School Trip to English Institute of Sport, Sheffield on 24th November



We are excited to inform you about an upcoming whole school trip to the English Institute of Sport in Sheffield on 24th November. This trip aims to provide an opportunity for our students to develop the skills they have been learning in their PE lessons at a professional sports venue. Children will compete in a range of track and field events – including a sand pit for the long jump! Children will also have the opportunity to score points for their class, each representing a country that features in the upcoming Olympic games.

To ensure our students are comfortable and easily identifiable, we kindly request that they wear their PE kits with the school logo on the day of the trip. The PE kits will enable our children to participate fully in the activities and enjoy the experience to the fullest extent.

As it is an all-day trip, children will require plenty of water, snacks along with a packed lunch. However, glass bottles, cans or fizzy drinks are not allowed for safety reasons.

For children who are entitled to free school meals, please be aware that you can order a lunch through the school office or message us on the app. If you would like this service, please let us know by the 15th of November so that we can adequately plan for the trip.

The journey to and from the English Institute of Sport will be made by coach. The coach will depart from the school at 9am on 24th November. Please can all children be at school before this time for a timely departure. We expect to be back before the end of the school day, allowing your child to be dismissed as usual. If there is any delay to our journey, you will be kept up to date via the app (School Gateway).

If your child has any specific medical requirements or conditions, please ensure that any medication, i.e., inhalers, are in date and are in school on the day.

We believe that this trip will provide a valuable learning experience for our students, giving them the opportunity to engage in a sports environment outside the classroom.

This trip is fully funded by school. This decision was made due to the wonderful achievement of earning our prestigious 'Platinum' school games award alongside all the support we receive from parents during school events which has helped us save on the cost of transport to and from competitions.
