Attendance

Thank you supporting us with attendance. Government guidelines state that attending school is the key to your child doing well in school and establishing good routines for later life including the working world. Derbyshire County Council states that any child with attendance below 90% (whether authorised or unauthorised) is a persistent absentee and statistics show that children who are persistent absentees are less likely to achieve their full potential.

We do have a duty of care to follow up if children are not in school and to regularly inform parents/carers of their child's attendance. We promote attendance in a variety of ways including, class attendance races, celebrating good attendance, talking about the importance of coming to school and creating personalised plans to support individual children.

We open our gates in the morning at 8:20 am ready for the children to be in class at 8:30 am. Please speak with us if you are finding it tricky, for whatever reason, to get your child to school on time and we will do our best to support you and your child whether that is with morning routines or worries about coming to school.
