


Follow the SMART Rules

- Safe -

Stay safe on the Internet by not posting or sharing personal information, such as your name, address, school name or phone number.

You wouldn't give a stranger in the street personal information, so don't do it online.

Is there any information about yourself that is ok to share on the Internet?



Follow the SMART Rules

Meeting



The Internet provides us with lots of ways that we can talk to people online.

It is dangerous to meet someone that you've talked to online but never met.

If a person asks you to meet up, talk to a trusted adult.



Follow the SMART Rules

- Accepting -



There are lots of ways to download and receive information on the Internet.

You may receive an email, pop-up message, text or picture from someone you don't know.

If you receive something on the Internet and you don't know who it is from, tell a trusted adult before opening it.


Follow the SMART Rules

Reliable

Not everyone that uses the Internet is trustworthy and not everything on the Internet is true.

Anyone can add or change information on the Internet, or lie about who they are.

Only use websites that you trust for information and if you are unsure about anything talk to a trusted adult.



Follow the SMART Rules

- Tell



Tell a trusted adult if you see something online or receive an online message that makes you feel worried or comfortable.
